Save on Dues Withholding. When you receive a notice about renewing your NARFE membership, you can save by enrolling in Dues Withholding. You save \$6 annually. You also save by not having to take the time to deal with the annual renewal activity in the future. It is easy. Just fill out the DW application in NARFE magazine and send it in.

Chapter's proposal to revise the NARFE Legislative Program. This proposal for NARFE to support legislation to increase Social Security benefits was sent to HQ last February. I sent inquiring emails to National Officers asking what was going on about two months ago and got no response until last week. It was along the line of: "This is really complicated and we have not figured out how to deal with it." When I learn more I will let you know. What gives this some urgency is that the House of Representatives may vote shortly to approve Rep. Larson's proposal to improve Social Security benefits.
