CONTACTING YOUR ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES

As you ought to be aware, the 2017 revision to the Federal tax code significantly limited the amount of state income and property taxes that can be deducted from Federal income tax. If, because you don't itemize these deductions on your Federal tax return – you use the new increased Federal deduction ceiling – you now can't itemize them on your Maryland income tax return.

The result for many of us is that we pay more tax to Maryland than we ought to! The Maryland General Assembly DID NOT pass legislation this year to correct this; NARFE has raised this issue and we need NARFE members to get their representatives to understand this and correct it!

You may contact your elected representatives utilizing the NARFE homepage. The following steps will allow you to both identify all your elected representatives, on both the federal and state levels, and to send them a message, telling them about the above issue, and other issues that are important to you as a NARFE member: (1) go to the NARFE homepage, narfe.org, and sign in as a member (if you have not already done this, it is a straight-forward procedure; just follow the prompts you'll be given); (2) once on NARFE's homepage, scroll down the far left column to reach "What You Can Do Online"; click on "Legislative Action Center"; (3) in the far left column on this page under "Advocacy," click on "Contact Your Legislators"; (4) scroll all the way to the bottom of this screen - under "Find Politicians," fill in your zip code, and click on the small arrow in the circle; (5) fill in your home address; again, click on the small arrow in the circle; (6) you'll be given a list of all your specific legislators, from federal to state; (7) click on the legislator's name, and you will be shown his or her address; click on the box to the left of that legislator's name, and then click on the red "Compose Message" at the bottom of this page. There will be a box for you to compose your message to him or her.
