Recent State Legislative Bills

Senate Bill 946 -- Concerns State Prescription Drug Benefits, Retiree Benefits. Establishes certain out-of-pocket limits under the Maryland State <u>Retiree Prescription Drug Coverage</u> <u>Program</u> for certain retirees; authorizing the Maryland State Retiree Prescription Drug Coverage Program to include a certain health reimbursement account or other program; authorizing certain individuals to enroll in the Maryland State Retiree Prescription Drug Coverage Program during a certain open enrollment or special enrollment period; etc. See <u>https://legiscan.com/MD/text/SB946/2019</u>

House Bill 768 -- Establishes the <u>Prescription</u> <u>Drug Affordability</u> Board to protect State residents and certain stakeholders from the high costs of prescription drug products; etc. See <u>https://legiscan.com/MD/text/HB768/2019</u>

Senate Bill 311 – Authorizes an individual to request <u>aid in dying</u> by making specified requests; prohibiting another individual from requesting aid in dying on behalf of an individual; requiring a certain request to be made in a certain manner; etc. See https://legiscan.com/MD/bill/SB311/2019
