'All NARFE meetings at the National, State, and local level have been cancelled or postponed since March. Until Governor Hogan lifts the prohibition on gatherings of no more than 10 people, all NARFE in person meetings will be cancelled.

Vote 2020 – Important dates

If you haven't registered to vote yet- you can register in person **until Oct 13.** You can get applications at (Voterservices.elections.maryland.gov/OnlineVoterRegistration). You will need a Maryland issued ID. You can also get Applications At the County Election Board, Health Departments, Motor Vehicle Administration.... if the offices are open. **After Oct 13** you can register to vote In person at early voting centers starting Oct 26 or on Election Day Nov 3.

Early voting: you can drop off your completed ballots starting Sept 28 at ballot drop boxes (270 are planned through out MD) . If you want to vote early in person, early voting centers will be open at 7am Oct 26 and everyday (including Sat & Sun) through Nov 3rd.

Voting by mail: Unlike the primary election, registered voters will have to **REQUEST** an absentee ballot (**no reason necessary**). You can request an application for absentee ballot from your local election board up to Oct 24. After Oct 24 you can still get an absentee ballot by visiting your Election Board. Requested Ballots will be mailed to you beginning Sept 24. You can fill them out (postage is prepaid) and mail the completed ballot in or drop it in a ballot drop box beginning on Sep 28. Recommend you vote by mail/drop box early to avoid USPS delays or weather delays.

Polling locations for in person voting (open Oct 26 – Nov3) are often manned by senior citizens. If the Covid-19 situation is dire- expect fewer polling workers to be available and polling places to be consolidated.
