#### IN MEMORIAM - DICK STROMBOTNE

NARFE has lost one of its most dedicated, hardworking members ever in the history of our organization. Dick worked tirelessly on behalf of NARFE's Maryland chapters, our state's Federation, and national NARFE, and he will be greatly missed by all who knew and worked with him. He passed away, after a long illness, on August 25, 2020, at the age of 87. Dick graduated with a Bachelor's of Arts from Claremont California's Pomona College, and earned his masters degree, and his doctorate, both in Physics, at the Berkeley campus of the University of California. He joined the staff of the Radio Standards Laboratory, part of what is now the National Bureau of Standards, in Boulder, Colorado in 1961; in 1968 he transferred to the U.S. Department of Transportation, working in the office of the Secretary, and in 1977 he transferred to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration where he worked until his retirement in 1996. His professional accomplishments were many and incredibly impressive.

Dick and his wife Marty celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary in August of 2012. Their four adult children, Laura, Mark, Tom, and Brian, joined them in this happy and auspicious occasion. Dick and Marty have several grand children and great grand children.

Dick joined NARFE in 1996; he attended all of Maryland's NARFE Federation's conventions, and NARFE's national conventions, having authored several resolutions which were adopted at national conventions. He also served twice on the national convention's Legislation Committee, and ran as a candidate for NARFE's National Treasurer. Dick served as president of the Gaithersburg NARFE Chapter 581 from 2002 to 2004, and was President of NARFE's Maryland Federation. On numerous occasions Dick gave testimony before the Maryland General Assembly on issues of importance to NARFE. Maryland Governor Ehrlich appointed Dick, as NARFE's representative, to the Maryland Elderly Migration Task Force in 2004. Dick was inducted into the Maryland Senior Citizens Hall of Fame, and additionally received the Care One Blue Cross Blue Shield Distinguished Annuitant Award.

Dick's wife Marty also has worked ceaselessly for their NARFE Chapters, and for the MD Federation. Together they formed a team that all levels of NARFE owe an extreme offer of gratitude for all their work for NARFE, and for being an example of truly exemplary outstanding members of NARFE.
